Also, big thank you to our Media mogul Elaine Scotney, she drove our Socials, information delivery, amongst other hats to really get our club out there.

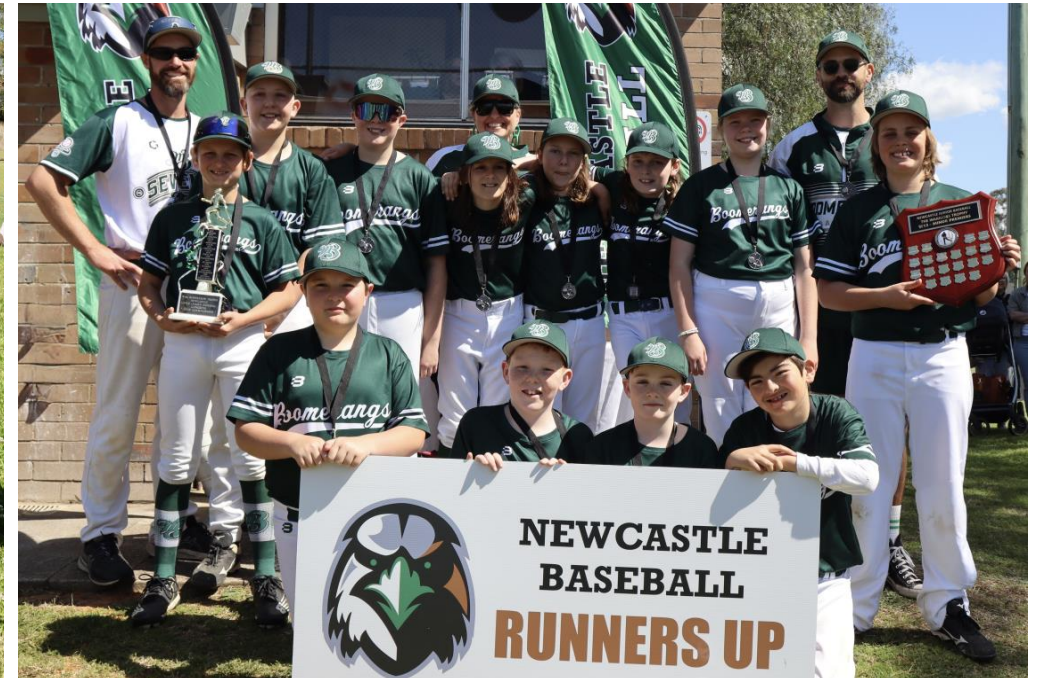
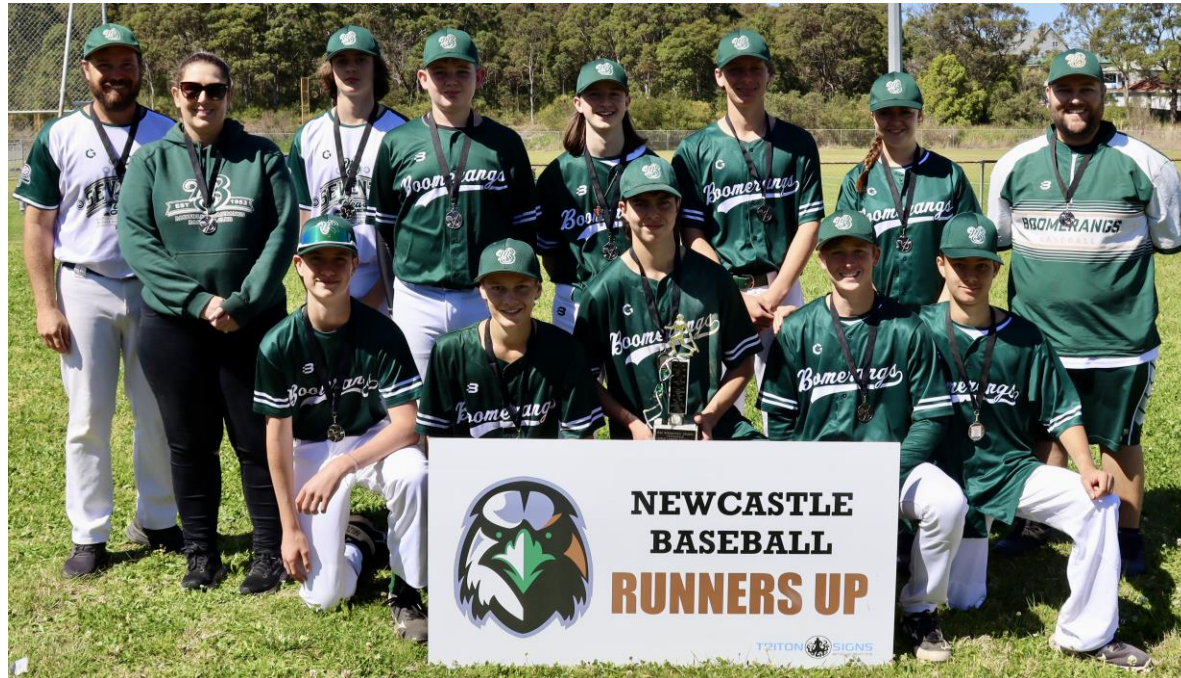
I would like to mention that this year we had a lot of Sponsorship, it is the most I think the Club has ever had, so shout out to Ann Voigt. Massive THANK YOU!

Our games at the end of the season were a highlight. Seeing the kids put into practice the skills they had learned was great and hopefully they will continue on next season with more opportunities to play.

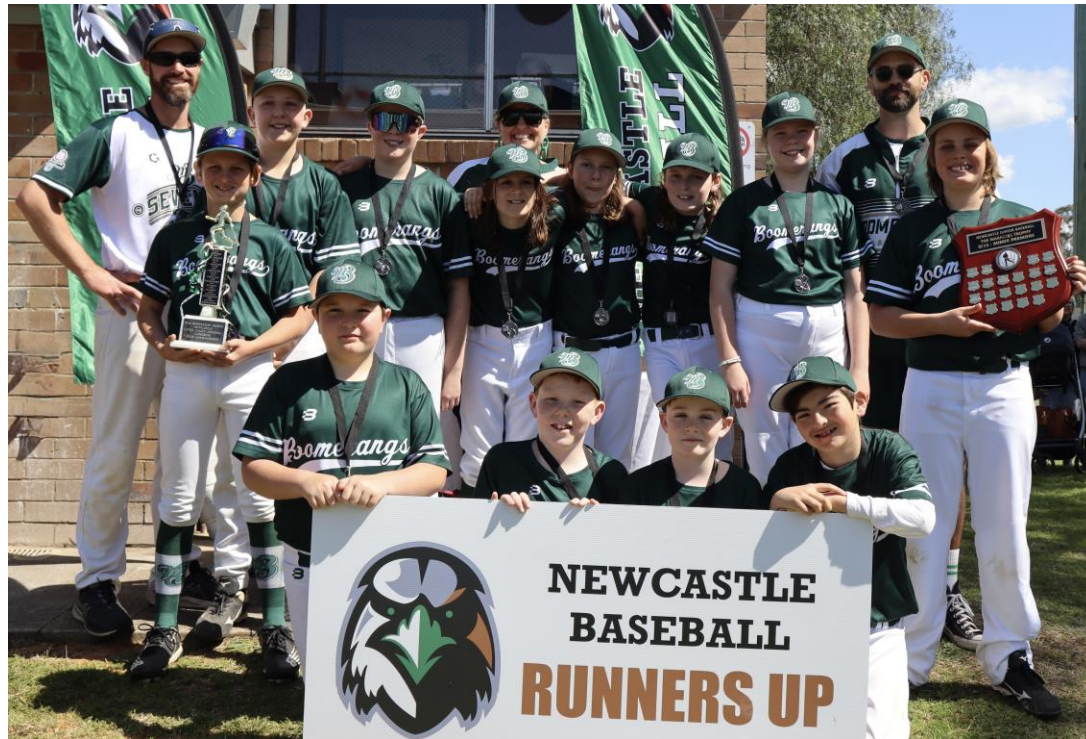
